4.1 MAP Results

4.1.1 Reading:

- In Fall of 19-20, 44% of students scored above the 40th percentile
- In Fall of 20-21, 68% of students scored above the 40th percentile

4.1.2 Math:

- In Fall of 19-20, 32% of students scored above the 40th percentile
- In Fall of 20-21, 62% of students scored above the 40th percentile

4.1.3 MAP Insights: Our K-2 students showed significant increase in growth, which is atypical growth. Typically, our Kindergarten students would grow in Reading is about 40% and approximately 35 % in Math. What we are noticing is that the parents of K-2 supported students more than the teacher would. However, 3-5 students grew at a more typical rate, which could be due to lack of assistance from home. When we test in December, it would be helpful to have input from the SOT parents to inform all parents not to provide large amounts of assistance during the MAP test for more accurate data collection.
